





PRESENTATION



The tournament is held mainly in two gymnasiums:

- The Lycée de Saint-Romain-en-Gal gymnasium, with parquet flooring and a 700seat grandstand.
- The Ampuis multi-purpose hall, with a 200-seat stand.

Every year, our tournament brings together French teams participating in the French championship, such as J.L. Bourg (three-time winner), Chorale de Roanne and Élan Chalon (each winner once), as well as ASVEL (finalist). The tournament also welcomes teams from all over Europe, including Italy, Spain, Lithuania, Latvia, Serbia, the Czech Republic, Germany and Slovenia.



In 2023, for the first time, the International Tournament welcomed, in addition to the men's competition, 5 women's teams: SGOSFF (France), AVSR (France), LEGANES (Spain), MILANO BASKET STARS (Italy) and UDINE (Italy). This year's event was a resounding success, encouraging us to continue with this format in future years.



All tournament matches, whether in the group stages or the finals, are supervised by official referees and table officials appointed by the F.F.B.B. On arrival, teams receive the tournament rules and all the information they need to organize their stay. This festive weekend also includes a dunk contest and a 3-point shooting competition.



TOURNAMENT ORGANIZATION

Article 1: The 8 teams are organized in 2 groups of 4 teams. Each team plays against the other three in the group.

Article 2: Group matches, semi-finals and the final for 3rd place are played in 4 quarters of 7 minutes each, interruptions being deducted. There is a 2-minute break between quarters and a 5-minute break at half-time.

One timeout in 1st half and two timeouts in 2nd half for each team.

A player is out after 5 fouls.

In case of a draw at the end of full time: a 4-minute extra time. If teams are again level, there will be 5 free throws by each team with the players on the court at the end of the match.

The final will be played in 4 quarters of 10 minutes each, interruptions being deducted (international rules).

Article 3:

- Teams finishing 1 and 2 in each group will play the semi-finals, then the final for 3rd place and the final.
- Teams finishing 3 in each group will play classifying match for 5th place.
- Teams finishing 4 in each group will play classifying match for 7th place.

Article 3 bis: if some teams are level at the end of groups matches:

- If 2 teams are level, the winning team of the group match will come before the losing team;
- If 3 teams are level, the average basket between the 3 teams will determine the order.

Article 4 : teams have a 15-minute warm-up period as soon as the previous match is over. The score table triggers the stopwatch.

Article 5: Any dispute shall be settled by a committee of 3 members (2 from the organizing committee and the referees' supervisor).

Article 6: Matches will be held by official referees chosen by a representative of the Regional League basketball and score table officials chosen by representatives of the Regional League.





GENERAL ORGANIZATION

Article 1: In the event of a dispute over the rules enforcement (and not the game itself), the 3-member organization committee, MM. Jean-Paul Boyron, Frédéric Faivre and Jean-Jacques Tatgé will settle the dispute.

Article 2: Each team must have 2 sets of shorts and jerseys of different colours.

Article 3: Each delegation will have the necessary insurance documents covering hospital and medical costs in case of an accident, players', coaches' and chaperons' liability insurance.

ASVR Basket declines all responsibility in this respect.

Each player and coach taking part in the tournament will have a valid license from his federation for the 2024/25 season.

Article 4: Players and coaches will be asked to leave the facilities clean, particularly changing rooms. In case of breach of the rules, the tournament organizers will be able to take all the necessary measures, including the expulsion of a team from the tournament.

Article 5: players and coaches must be present 15 minutes before starting warm-up.

Article 6: throughout the tournament, from Friday, (dinner time) until Monday (breakfast), the organizing committee will provide meals for 12 players and 3 coaches in each team. Sunday evening meals are not provided by the organization. Any other meal(s) taken elsewhere will be covered by the delegation(s) concerned.

Article 7: On arrival, the tournament organizers will give each team a folder with all the necessary information regarding their stay (tournament rules, meals organization, accommodation sites).

ORGANIZATION OF MEALS AND ACCOMMODATION



Support from AVSR Basket

The organizing club AVSR Basket will provide all meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) from Friday April 18 at 4pm to Sunday April 20 at noon for 15 people (12 players + 3 coaches and assistants). Sunday lunch is free (no club canteen). If there are extra people, they will have to pay for their meal or take their meal outside the tournament organization.

Team invitations

Teams are invited by the organization. There is no registration fee.

Accommodation: various options

Teams have a choice of accommodation in Vienna's various hotels.

Depending on the team's choice, reservations will be made by the tournament organizer to benefit from preferential rates. Each sports delegation must indicate the number of people to be accommodated, with a breakdown of players/coaches and managers, and the number of days of accommodation (Friday/Saturday/Sunday or Friday/Saturday). Rooms must be paid for by bank transfer one month before the start of the tournament (i.e. end of February 2025).

Options:

Accommodation in Vienna hotels

The following group rates have been negotiated by the tournament organizer with hotel management. Reservations can be made by the tournament organizers on a space-available basis.

- Hotel Ibis Saint Louis (500 m from the main gymnasium)
 33 € / night / person in a 2-person room (either 1 double bed or 2 single beds, subject to availability)
- Hotel Ibis Budget Vienne Sud (center of Vienne, 1.5 km from the main gymnasium)
 24 € / night / person (either 1 double bed or 2 single beds, subject to availability)
- Hotel Classe 1 (in the northern district of Vienna, 2.5 km from the main gymnasium)
 16 € / night / person (2 or 3 person room)
